1. Divisions and Age Requirements

<i>Divisions</i>	<i>Age Requirements</i>
18 years and Under (Boys & Girls)	Born on or after 01/01/2002
16 years and Under (Boys & Girls)	Born on or after 01/01/2004
14 years and Under (Boys & Girls)	Born on or after 01/01/2006
12 years and Under (Boys & Girls)	Born on or after 01/01/2008
10 years and Under (Boys & Girls)	Born on or after 01/01/2010 - minimum age 8 years, i.e. born in 2011

2. Fees and Nominations

Nomination fees are **\$240.00** per team (inclusive of GST). Team nominations are to be through Ipswich touch via nomination form at the end of this document .Payment must be received by Ipswich Touch Association by no later than Tuesday, 19 May 2020. The preferred payment method is by direct deposit into the following account:

NB. Preference will be given to team nominations from SWQ affiliates.

3. Refunds

If an affiliate enters a team (or teams) and subsequently withdraws any of them after the closing date of 19 May 2020, the team entry fee **will not** be refunded.

4. Managers Meeting

There will be a managers meeting held 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the first games. A representative from each affiliate should be present at this meeting and then convey this information to their coaches and managers.

5. Team Registration Sheet

A team registration sheet is to be submitted to the administration area prior to the team's first game. Only players whose names are shown on that list will be allowed to participate for that team.



6. Team Numbers For All Age Groups

10s Divisions

Teams may only register and use a maximum of **12 players** in a game.

12s, 14s, 16s & 18s Divisions

Teams may only register and use a maximum of **14 players** in a game.

Any team found guilty of either using more than the stipulated number of players or using an unregistered player may be disqualified from the event.

7. Team & Player Eligibility

This event is for representative teams from TFA affiliated competitions only. It is the responsibility of each affiliate to ensure that their players and officials are registered and fully financial members of all affiliated bodies. To be eligible to participate, players must have played seven (7) games in an affiliated Season 2 (2019) or Season 1 (2020) competition with the affiliate they are representing at this tournament. NB. Boys may only play in the boys' division and girls may only play in the girls' division. Invitational teams may be accepted if it suits the draw.

8. Player Eligibility For Finals

To be eligible to participate in the finals series, players must have participated in at least one round game.

9. Medallions

The winners and runners-up in each division will be presented with medallions.

10. Insurance

The TFA Accident Insurance Scheme covers all players and officials who have met the insurance criteria for a current TFA affiliated competition.

11. Referees

Every team **MUST** supply a referee with minimum Level 1 accreditation. Referees are required to wear their standard uniform - with specific local association uniforms being acceptable. Referees will be paid as follows:

<u>Divisions</u>	<u>Payment Amount</u>
10s	\$10 per solo – only 1 referee for these games
12s & 14s	\$20.00 per solo and \$10.00 per dual
16s & 18s	\$15 per dual or \$10 per triple – no solos.



Referees are to provide their bank account details (on the form supplied) to the referee coordinator at the start of the day. Ipswich Touch will deposit payment into their account within 3 working days. **No payments will be made to referees at the event.** The referee coordinator will have authority over referees in matters pertaining to the tournament during the course of the day. Team nominated referees will be required to officiate on a minimum of 4 games.

12. Code of Conduct

It is the responsibility of the team managers and affiliate coordinators to be responsible for, and proactive towards, the good behaviour of players, coaches, managers and spectators. The tournament committee **will not** tolerate abuse towards officials, referees or players. The spirit of the game will not be compromised at this event. Coaches or managers who have received an official warning from the tournament committee, or a representative of the committee, will incur the following:

- i. Second offence - Loss of 2 competition points for their team
- ii. Third offence - Team disqualification

13. Competition Format

- i. A round robin format will be used for preliminary games.
- ii. Where pools are required, cross over semi-finals will be played.
- iii. Positions for the finals will be determined by:
 - Teams with the highest points at the completion of round games
 - If equal - For and Against
 - If equal - Result of round game
 - If equal - Percentages
 - If still equal – Coin toss

14. Competition Points & Rules

Points will be allocated as follows: 3 (win), 2 (draw), 1 (loss) & 0 (forfeit). All games will be played under the ATA 8th edition rules.

15. Game Duration

- i. **ALL** games will have 15 minute halves with a 2 minute half time break.
- ii. Drop-offs will only apply to quarters, semis and finals.

16. Medical

First Aid will be available on the day for the treatment of minor injuries sustained at this tournament, not for strapping of injuries, pre-existing conditions or rub-downs. An ambulance will be called for more serious injuries.



17. Tents

Whilst there is adequate shade available at the Redbank Recreational Reserve affiliates that wish to bring a tent must contact the Ipswich Falcons Administrator in advance for authorisation.

18. Alcohol and Venue

Alcohol cannot be brought into the association premises. Spectators are not permitted into areas where fields are situated side by side. This area is reserved for players and officials. Managers are required to ask spectators supporting their teams to vacate these areas during the course of games.

19. Tournament Control

The tournament committee is in control of all matters relating to this tournament. This committee and the tournament director will determine items not covered in the 'Conditions of Entry'. The tournament committee hold the right to amend or change the Conditions of Entry, with the nominated representative from each affiliate being informed of any change.

20. Wet Weather

In the event of wet weather, Ipswich Falcons Touch Association will contact the nominated representative from each affiliate immediately a decision has been made. The wet weather details will also be posted on the Ipswich Touch Association website www.ipswichtouch.com and on the Ipswich Falcons Juniors Facebook page.
